

Did you know there are changes to your concession travel with CountryLink?



Pensioner Travel Vouchers

As a NSW pensioner you are still entitled to four Pensioner Travel Vouchers each calendar year. Each voucher covers a single (one-way) economy or first class journey, excluding sleeping berths, on a CountryLink train or coach service within NSW.

From 1 March 2006 when you book travel using a Pensioner Travel Voucher you will need to pay a booking fee that's 15 per cent of the full adult fare for the entire journey or a minimum of \$10. A booking fee will be charged for each of your vouchers, which are valid for single, one-way trips.

Please remember that you need to book travel with Pensioner Travel Vouchers ahead of time and you will be charged the standard concession fare if you board a CountryLink service without booking ahead.

You can book by calling **13 22 32** or visiting a CountryLink travel centre, booking office, selected CityRail stations or accredited travel agent.

Country Pensioner Excursion tickets

Are you a pensioner or war widow/er from NSW, Victoria or the ACT?
Or holder of a government-issued Seniors Card who lives in NSW,
Victoria or the ACT?

Well, if you are, you're entitled to travel on CountryLink trains and coaches using a Country Pensioner Excursion ticket that gives you a reduced fare.

From 1 March 2006 there will be a few changes to the way you can use these tickets. Each \$2.50 ticket will be valid for a single journey as long as you reach your destination on the same day you begin travelling. If you do stop off along the way you'll need to make sure you don't spend longer than 12 hours there because you'll then need to buy another ticket. You'll also need to buy a new \$2.50 ticket to return even if it's on the same day.

Of course, if you board a CountryLink service before midnight and arrive after 12.00am the next day, your Country Pensioner Excursion ticket will cover it.

Country Pensioner Excursion tickets cannot be purchased from CityRail stations or CountryLink travel centres and accredited travel agencies inside the area bounded by Sydney, Nowra, Moss Vale, Lithgow, Muswellbrook, Dungog, Karuah and Booral.

You can book your Country Pensioner Excursion ticket up to seven days ahead of your trip by calling **13 22 32** or visiting a CountryLink travel centre, booking office or accredited travel agent. If you book over the phone, just pop into your local CountryLink travel centre or travel agent to pick up your ticket.
